Why defence cooperation?

- Aliansi
- Capacity building: training and education
- Information sharing
- Confidence building
- Conflict prevention and management
- Peace-keeping initiatives
- Defence industry
- Joint/coordinated operations in specific contexts

Sweden

- Neutral country with no geopolitical/strategic stakes in the region, so politically safe
- Similar environment : long coast line and seas facing with multiple fronts/open
- Willing to transfer technology and training and education
- A package of defence products: missiles, fighters, and radar (surveillance and early warning)
- Best experience in defending the country against external powers (particularly Russia): situational awareness, silent electronic networking, and they are faced with “as soon as we take off, the jamming (from Russia) starts”. (Col. Anders Persson, Sweden AF)
- Strong export tradition/orientation → international customers in mind

Cases

- Brazil: Gripen and torpedo, education and training for AF and Navy, and trade
- Thailand: Gripen and considering submarines after cancelling China submarines
- HK: AAB robotic technology
- Singapore: Submarines, Giraffe (radar), and patrol vessels
- UAE: GlobalEye airborne early warning
